

Minutes of School Community Council Meeting

Tuesday, September 1, 2015

About 2:30 P.M.

Brooke Petersen, Kristine Laws, Tabitha Kelly, and Brydi Sharp representing the Parent Members were in attendance.

Ellen Hadfield, Melissa Huntington, Vondakay Lofley, and Sheresa Jensen were not in attendance.

School Council Members in attendance were: Carli O'Neil, Nancy Hansen, and Jerel Lofley.

Brooke Petersen, Chairman, conducted the meeting.

The minutes for the School Community Council Meeting held April 10, 2015, were reviewed. Carli O'Neil made a motion to approve the minutes. Nancy Hansen seconded the motion. The minutes were approved.

One School Community Council application has been received. It was submitted by Sharon Burgess. It was determined an election would not be necessary. Vondakay Lofley's term is ending. Sheresa Jensen will no longer be serving as a member of the Council. Brydi Sharp's term is ending, but she is willing to continue to serve. The current School Land Trust plan for 2015-2016 was reviewed. Some expenditures have been made for summer school salaries, projectors, and online software. The online software program of Raz Kids was discussed. Jerel Lofley is to look into the possibilities of purchasing it. Reading Horizons K-3 software was discussed. We have fifteen licenses for our school currently. It is not online. Education City, online software used at school and available at home for students was also discussed.

For this year, we have received some additional money in addition to what was budgeted.

The possibility of using Trust Land money to purchase Science Spin or other periodicals for student use was discussed.

For this year extra money has been budgeted for the purchase of science materials. Jerel Lofley is to inform the teachers so they can purchase appropriate materials.

The possibility of including singing and learning to play the recorder with our fine arts was discussed.

Last spring Carli O'Neil submitted Cleveland Elementary's entry to Trust Lands for a chance to win \$1000 dollars for our school, but we did not win.

It was suggested that a formal motion be given to have Brydi Sharp continue as a member of the School Community Council for another term.

Carli O'Neil made a motion to have Brydi Sharp continue as a member of the School Community Council and to accept Sharon Burgess as a member of the Council as well. Brooke Petersen and others seconded the motion. It was approved.

Carli O'Neil moved to close the meeting. Brydi Sharp and others seconded the motion.
